POSTER CRITERIA

The purpose of the posters is to convey water reuse scientific research, applications or new management information to professionals and the general public. We are looking for submissions that include case studies, alternative analysis, new methodologies, and scientific information on new products or tools related to the field of water reuse and conservation, groundwater, regulations/policies and watershed management.

POSTER review process

Submission Requirements Below (no fee)

Review of submissions and abstracts will be based on:

- Objectives
- Case Study
- Significance to Water Reuse or Conservation
- Methodology
- Results
- Future Research or Applications

VENDOR/Booth Submissions

Booth Space Availability (\$150/\$60 non-profit)
November 1-4, 2016

In addition to poster submissions, booth/table space will be available on a limited basis. Rates do not include Conference Registration. Vendor/Booth submissions will be given priority to the following:

- Educational, non-profit or agency
- Significance to Water Reuse or Conservation
- Applicable products of significance
- Applicable programs or projects of significance

POSTER Submissions

Please provide the following in your submission:

- Contact Information: Poster presenter's full contact information (this will be printed on the poster header by conference organizers)
- Poster Title: Maximum 12 words
- Topics: Select up to two topics
- Poster Description: Maximum 550 characters (approximately 100 words) – for use on online scheduler, mobile app and other online marketing tools. The Poster Description must explain what the attendee will take away upon viewing your poster.
- Extended Abstract & Results: Details on what your session is about including examples and demonstrated results that will help the Content Review Committee better understand the technical merits of your poster submission. This will not be published.
- Poster Presenter Information: Presenter's full contact information (can be different from submitter's information)
- Poster Presenter Biography: Maximum 100 words
- Poster: Submit a PDF file of poster if available at time of submission.
- SEO Keywords: Add a maximum of 4 keywords to help optimize your poster for search engines (SEO)
- Supporting Material (Optional): Provide supplemental information that supports your poster submission. Additional materials may include white papers, research work, videos, images, demos, proof of concept, etc.
- Free 1-day conference registration for presenter
- All posters will be displayed on easels (not provided).
